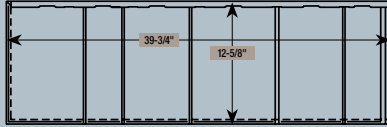


The Cool Roof Rating Council (CRRC) is an independent nonprofit organization that lists a third-party rating system for the radiative properties of roof surfacing materials. A cool roof has the ability to accomplish two things: 1) reflect the sun's energy (solar reflectance) and 2) quickly give off any heat that it does absorb (thermal emittance). The higher the reflectance and emittance ratings, the more "cool" a product is considered to be. The benefits of a cool roof can include increased indoor comfort, reduced cooling costs™ and help with local code compliance in areas where cool roofing is a requirement.
